

The Hon. and Rt. Revd John Harley (29 September 1728 – 7 January 1788)

Rector of St Marylebone (1788)

The Hon. John Harley was the second son of Edward Harley, 3rd Earl of Oxford and Earl Mortimer.

He was Archdeacon of Shropshire from 1760 to 1769 and then Archdeacon of Hereford from 1769 to 1787.

He was Dean of Windsor (1778 – 1788), Registrar of the Order of the Garter and briefly, at the end of his life, Bishop of Hereford.

His son Edward (by his wife Roach Vaughan, the daughter of Gwynne Vaughan of Trebarry, Radnorshire) succeeded John Harley's elder brother (Edward), as 5th Earl of Oxford.
