The Scheme of the St Marylebone Educational Foundation enables

- grants to be made available towards the school fees of pupils at secondary schools anywhere in Great Britain
- help towards the cost of education; for example music lessons, drama clubs, extra tuition etc. for children at school in the London Borough of Westminster.

However it must be noted that

- grants are only for a percentage of the fees and additional funding must be available to those applying

Eligibility Criteria

- if the parents (or guardian) and child have resided in the City of Westminster for a minimum of two years, with special priority for those in the old London Borough of St Marylebone.
- if the child has received primary or secondary education in the City of Westminster, with special priority for those in the old London Borough of St Marylebone, for two years.

Special consideration may apply to those children already at secondary school where parents may have run into financial difficulty during their child's education.

The grants are intended to aid children who might be prevented by lack of finance to obtain the benefit of enhancements to their education or education at an independent school.
